Proposed Amendment #20 To The Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery Program Action Plan For Disaster Recovery

The Town of Union is proposing an amendment to the Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Action Plan for Disaster Recovery. The amendment authorizes the addition of a new project as an eligible activity as follows:

Refuse Garage Construction

The town previously allocated CDBG-DR funds for the purchase of land required to relocate the refuse garage that was damaged in the 2011 flood event to a new location outside of the flood plain. The construction of the new facility is being funded primarily by the Governor's Office of Storm Recovery (GOSR), however the bids received for the project exceeded the amount of funds available from GOSR. Portions of the project are being re-bid.

This amendment will also allow Town of Union to utilize CDBG-DR funds allocated directly to the town, as necessary and appropriate, to supplement GOSR funding. A separate Public Notice will be issued identifying the budget lines from which funds will be re-allocated to the Refuse Garage Construction project.
