(Endwell, NY) The Town of Union Economic Development Office announces the creation and implementation of a new \$1,500,000.00 grant program – the ‘Town of Union Local Development Corporation (LDC) 2021 American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Grant Program’ – to help start-up and established businesses and commercial property owners. The town includes the villages of Endicott and Johnson City, and the hamlets of Endwell, Choconut Center, Union Center, West Corners, Westover, and West Endicott.

This new \$1,500,000.00 ARPA Grant Program is comprised of five types of grant programs, which are designed to provide town businesses with further opportunities for growth, expansion and improvement. The five innovative grant programs include:

- Kick-Start Entrepreneurial Grant Program
- Small Business Sustainability Grant Program
- Project Specific Infrastructure Improvement Grant Program
- Reimagine Union Demolition & Site Prep Grant Program
- 50/50 Commercial Façade Grant Program
