B. Mr. Moody presented a proposal to establish a Town of Union National Disaster Assistance Recovery (Ndarp) Loan Program. The purpose is to assist town businesses in retaining jobs held by low to moderate income employees. The basis of the proposal is the detrimental effect of the coronavirus on local businesses. Draft documentation provided to the Board included a loan application form, a guide to CDBG eligible activities, and a description of the new loan program. The LDC Board is awaiting a response from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to the Town of Union Local Development Corporation's request for HUD approval of the proposed Ndarp Loan Program. After discussion of the program terms, and due to the intermittent functioning of the conference call system, a special LDC Board meeting was scheduled for 7:30 a.m. on March 25, 2020.
