Resolution to enter into a Master Bridge NY Local Project agreement with the NYSDOT for the bridge rehabilitations of Country Club Road (BIN2225790) over Patterson Creek, P.I.N. 9754.44, to perform the Preliminary Engineering (Phases 1-4) and the Right-of-Way Incidentals work for the above-mentioned project, and authorize Supervisor Rose A. Sotak to execute all required documents. The estimated cost of the Preliminary Engineering work (Phase 1-4) is \$80,000.00. The Town will be reimbursed 95% of the\$80,000 or \$76,000, with Federal Funds. The estimated cost for the Right-of-Way Incidentals works is \$7,000. The Town will be reimbursed 95% of \$7,000, or \$6,650 with Federal Funds. Therefore, the necessary Town Resolution must authorize \$87,000.00 for these phases of the project.
