The cost shall be \$475.00 for services related to temporary easements required for the project. The price for each easement is the same as outlined in the May 2016 RFP that was received and approved by the Town Board. Twelve temporary easements are needed for the project and will be paid from the Town's CDBG-DR grant.

<u>Resolution</u> to authorize the continuation of the contract with "Greenskeeper" for Lawn Maintenance for 2017 for Town of Union Owned Properties West Corners Area (Buyout). The contract states "The contract term will be incremental and may be extended for the next two



(2) years upon mutual consent of the Town and the Contractor." This will be the final year of the contract and the contract will remain at \$7,920.00.

<u>Resolution</u> to enter into a Master Bridge NY Local Project agreement with the NYSDOT for the bridge rehabilitation of Country Club Road (BIN 2225790) over Patterson Creek, P.I.N. 9754.44, to perform the Preliminary Engineering Design work and the Right-of-Way Incidentals work for the above-mentioned project, and authorize Supervisor Rose A. Sotak to execute all required documents.

The estimated cost of the Preliminary Engineering/Design work is \$200,000.00. The Town will be reimbursed 95% of the \$200,000 or \$190,000, with Federal Funds.

The estimated cost for the Right-of-Way Incidentals work is \$7,000. The Town will be reimbursed 95% of \$7,000, or \$6,650 with Federal Funds.

Therefore, the necessary Town Resolution must authorize \$207,000.00 for these phases of the project.

**Motion** to authorize the attendance of Chet Kupiec and eight (8) highwaymen to attend the Dig Safely Seminar to be held at the Watkins Glen Community Center on March 30, 2017. There is no cost for this event. Authorization to include the use of Town vehicles.
