Federal Fiscal Year 2007 CDBG Applications Now Available

Applications for Community Development Block Grant funding for Federal Fiscal Year 2007 (10/1/2007 through 9/30/2008) are now available on the Town of Union web page (www.townofunion.com). On the left side of the home page select Departments, then click on Community Development. The forms were prepared using Adobe Acrobat and can be filled out on-line and printed. You must have Adobe Acrobat Reader in order to view and complete the documents. You can download Acrobat Reader (it's free) by using the link at the top of the web page. You will not be able to save the completed pages to your computer unless you have the full version of Adobe Acrobat. If necessary, you can also use the Print Form button on each page to print blank copies of the applications.

Please be sure to review the Application Instructions and Application Brochure prior to submitting your application.

Completed applications are due at the Town of Union Planning Department on or before 4:00 PM on Friday May, 4, 2007, no exceptions!

CDBG Funds Set To Make Local Parks Spring-Ahead

Just in time for an extra hour of daylight (before you go to bed this Sunday, March 11th, don't forget to set your clocks ahead one hour) plans are well underway for significant improvements at several local parks. You may have already noticed that the six-foot high barbed wire fencing has been removed at CFJ Park in Johnson City and replaced with a lower black vinyl-coated fence making the park look more like a park and less like a prison. New playground structures for CFJ, Floral Avenue, and GWJ parks have already been delivered and are ready to be installed as soon as weather permits. The units will also feature ADA compliant fall protection material for added safety. A new spray park, the first of its kind in Broome County, is also scheduled for construction this spring at West Endicott Park.
