Proposed Amendment #4 To The Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery Program Action Plan For Disaster Recovery

The Town of Union is proposing an amendment to the Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Action Plan for Disaster Recovery. The amendment will authorize an additional allocation (above the original estimate of \$150,000) in an amount not to exceed \$10,000 from the Unprogrammed/Contingency reserve fund in order to provide full funding for the construction of a new bathroom facility at Glendale Park. The additional funds are required to cover project delivery costs such as environmental studies, asbestos removal, and incidental construction contract contingencies.
