Proposed Amendment #6 To The Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery Program Action Plan For Disaster Recovery

The Town of Union is proposing an amendment to the Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Action Plan for Disaster Recovery. The amendment will authorize an extension of the Acquisition For Redevelopment activity to the Fairmont Park, South Endwell, and West Corners neighborhoods. The amendment further authorizes a transfer of CDBG-DR funds up to an amount currently estimated to be \$1,100,000 from the Town's CDBG-DR FEMA buyout project approved as part of the initial plan to the existing Acquisition for Redevelopment project identified in the same plan. This transfer of funds was made possible due to a commitment of other funding from New York State in support of the FEMA sponsored buyout program.
