#### **Narratives**

#### **Disaster Damage:**

The flooding that occurred September 7-9, 2011 severely affected five neighborhoods in the Town of Union and caused considerable damage in twelve others. The flooding that occurred both in 2005 and 2006 were confined to two major areas in the Town, those being the South Endwell area and the Fairmont Park subdivision. In 2011, in addition to these two areas, the Westover and West Corners areas were severely affected by flooding. Three of the areas, South Endwell, Fairmont Park, and Westover are affected by backwater from the Susquehanna River. West Corners is affected by the Nanticoke Creek. The Nanticoke Creek affects areas in the western part of the Town of Union including the Route 26 corridor, West Corners, Glendale Drive, and West Endicott. These areas are also subject to backwater effect of the Susquehanna River. That is, once the Susquehanna River rises above a certain stage, floodwaters from the Susquehanna River will back up into the Nanticoke Creek affecting properties in the western portion of the Town.

#### **Recovery Needs:**

Based upon the surveys, it appears that there are still substantial unmet needs in the community. Homeowners estimated unmet needs at approximately \$4.5 million (an average of \$37,488 per unit however this number includes properties that will be demolished) while business and non-profits estimated remaining unmet needs at just over \$3 million (an average of \$100,043).

In addition to the unmet housing and business needs previously identified, floodwaters took a significant toll on the basic infrastructure throughout the Town. Roads, storm water facilities, sanitary sewer plants, and water treatment plants also suffered significant damage and substantially complicated the Town's emergency response efforts. Many of these facilities were built decades ago and were not designed to handle subsequent population growth and resulting development. These facilities are overwhelmed by the ever increasing intensity of storm events and can't be maintained into the future without significant repairs and flood mitigation measures. Private utilities also experienced significant flood related damage to service delivery components.

#### **Public Comment:**

The Town received a total of sixteen (16) comments on the Action Plan prior to approval by the Town Board and subsequent submission to HUD. Many of the comments were directed at inadequate infrastructure or infrastructure that was damaged during the flood event. Several comments related to the potential use of CDBG-DR funds to assist property owners who wish to particiapte in the FEMA sponsored buy-out program.

## **Overall Progress Narrative:**

Bids for the JC Water Treatment Maintenance Facility have been received. The bids were higher than anticipated and the town is processing a Plan Amendment to allocate additional funds for the project. The town anticipates that contracts will be awarded in April and that construction will commence shortly thereafter. The project will also be partially funded with CDBG-DR funds (\$300,000) from the Governor's Office of Storm Recovery (GOSR) and a local contribution from the Village of Johnson City.

Bids were received for the JC Grand Ave./Interceptor B project storm/sanitary separation project. The bids were higher than anticipated and the town is processing a Plan Amendment to allocate additional funds for the project. A contract in the amount of \$945,000 has been awarded and construction is expected to begin as soon as weather permits.

Final design has been completed for the West Creek stream bank stabilization project. USACE and NYSDEC approvals have been secured. The project will be put out to bid during the next quarter. Due to NYSDEC and USACE regulations actual construction can't begin until after July 16, 2018. The project is expected to be completed this year.

The town issued public notices for two Plan Amendments during the report period ending on 3/31/18. The first amendment was to create an activity for construction of a new refuse garage outside of the floodplain. The town had previously used CDBG-DR funds to acquire the land needed for the new facility. The majority of the construction project is being funded by a CDBG-DR grant administered by GOSR. Bids were received for the project but were higher than the funding allocated by GOSR. The town intends to allocate \$450,000 from the town's CDBG-DR grant to supplement the GOSR funding. It should be noted that this is not a "new" project. The construction of a new refuse garage was originally identified as a "Proposed" project in the March 2014 NYRCR Broome NY Rising Community Reconstruction Plan prepared by GOSR. GOSR prepared a full environmental assessment for the project under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA).

The second plan amendment was issued to re-allocate funds from various project lines to provide additional funding for the Grand Ave./Interceptor B storm/sanitary separation, JC Water Treatment Plant Maintenance Building, and Refuse Garage construction projects.



As of the end of the report period, the town has expended \$\$6,700,278 (not including program income) of the \$10,137,818 grant (roughly 66%).

HUD has established tentative grant closeout target dates for CDBG-DR grantees. The current target closeout date for the town's grant is December 31, 2020. The town anticipates that it is on schedule to meet this target closeout date
