Proposed Amendment #9 To The Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery Program Action Plan For Disaster Recovery

The Town of Union is proposing an amendment to the Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Action Plan for Disaster Recovery. The amendment authorizes a commitment of CDBG-DR funds up \$45,000 from the Town's CDBG-DR unprogrammed funds budget line to create a construction bid contingency for flood prevention and drainage improvements at the Johnson City Senior Center, 30 Brocton St., Johnson City. The preliminary cost estimate for the base bid specification exceeds the amount currently allocated to the project. This amendment will allow the project to be put out to bid and awarded in a timely manner if the base bids fall within the amount of total funding available. Contingency funding for base bid alternates such as additional parking lot lighting may be made available at the sole discretion of the Town of Union.
