Narratives

Disaster Damage:

The flooding that occurred September 7-9, 2011 severely affected five neighborhoods in the Town of Union and caused considerable damage in twelve others. The flooding that occurred both in 2005 and 2006 were confined to two major areas in the Town, those being the South Endwell area and the Fairmont Park subdivision. In 2011, in addition to these two areas, the Westover and West Corners areas were severely affected by flooding. Three of the areas, South Endwell, Fairmont Park, and Westover are affected by backwater from the Susquehanna River. West Corners is affected by the Nanticoke Creek. The Nanticoke Creek affects areas in the western part of the Town of Union including the Route 26 corridor, West Corners, Glendale Drive, and West Endicott. These areas are also subject to backwater effect of the Susquehanna River. That is, once the Susquehanna River rises above a certain stage, floodwaters from the Susquehanna River will back up into the Nanticoke Creek affecting properties in the western portion of the Town.

Recovery Needs:

Based upon the surveys, it appears that there are still substantial unmet needs in the community. Homeowners estimated unmet needs at approximately \$4.5 million (an average of \$37,488 per unit however this number includes properties that will be demolished) while business and non-profits estimated remaining unmet needs at just over \$3 million (an average of \$100,043).

In addition to the unmet housing and business needs previously identified, floodwaters took a significant toll on the basic infrastructure throughout the Town. Roads, storm water facilities, sanitary sewer plants, and water treatment plants also suffered significant damage and substantially complicated the Town's emergency response efforts. Many of these facilities were built decades ago and were not designed to handle subsequent population growth and resulting development. These facilities are overwhelmed by the ever increasing intensity of storm events and can't be maintained into the future without significant repairs and flood mitigation measures. Private utilities also experienced significant flood related damage to service delivery components.

Public Comment:

The Town received a total of sixteen (16) comments on the Action Plan prior to approval by the Town Board and subsequent submission to HUD. Many of the comments were directed at inadequate infrastructure or infrastructure that was damaged during the flood event. Several comments related to the potential use of CDBG-DR funds to assist property owners who wish to particiapte in the FEMA sponsored buy-out program.

A number of the projects included in the HUD-approved Action Plan for Disaster Recovery are completed or currently underway.

The final version of a Long Term Community Recovery Strategy has been completed and printed. The first of the "catalytic redevelopment projects" highlighted in the plan is currently underway. A Purchase Option has been exercised for the sale of 12 parcels acquired through the CDBG-DR funded Acquisition for Redevelopment program. The lots will be developed in a flood resilient manner utilizing FEMA's development in the floodplain standards under a new construction program being funded through tax credits, CDBG-DR funding through the Governor's Office of Storm Recovery, and the Community Preservation Corp. The 22 new rental units will have the first floor elevations above the base flood elevation. The units will be rented to persons at or below 80% of the area's median income.

Repairs to several neighborhood facilities including the Union Volunteer Emergency Squad (UVES), Boys and Girls Club, the Westover YMCA, and the Johnson City Senior Center have been completed.

The drainage repairs/improvements that were recommended in Phase 1 of the N. Loder Ave. drainage



study are now completed. A contract for design services for Phase 2 improvements has been awarded and design options are being investigated. Soil borings have indicated that the most cost effective route for the new drainage pipe is not suitable due to poor soil conditions down to at least 50 feet below existing grade. The soil borings also indicated that even with the dry summer that the region has experienced, the location of proposed underground storm water detention is not feasible due to the water table being within 7 feet of existing grade. Required NEPA environmental review process is underway.

Creek bank repairs/improvements at Valleyview Dr. and Western Heights Blvd. have been completed.

The Endicott Storm Drainage Improvement project (Pine St.-McKinley Ave.) has been completed.

An RFQ for design services for the JC Water Treatment maintenance facility has been awarded and the design phase is underway. Actual construction is expected to begin in the first quarter of 2017.

A contract has been executed for design of the JC Interceptor B project and field survey work has been completed. The project is now in the design phase. The initial field survey work identified an issue that would significantly increase the cost of direct boring of the new storm pipe. The engineer and the Director of Public Services for the Village of Johnson City have approached the town with a proposed revision to the scope of this project that would connect it with the recently approved storm/sanitary separation project along Grand Ave. The engineer for the Interceptor B project has been authorized to conduct field survey work to determine if combining the two projects is technically feasible.

During the previous report period the town began the public notice process for Plan Amendment #17 which authorized two new projects including creek bank repairs/improvements along West Creek (\$570,000) and the Grand Avenue storm/sanitary separation project (\$375,000). Funding that was unspent from completed or cancelled projects was re-allocated to these new projects. The Town Board approved the Plan Amendment at the July 13, 2016 meeting. The Town Board recently indicated that the preliminary cost estimate for the relocation of the town's refuse garage out of the floodplain is more than the funding available through the NY Community Rising program. The Board will be reviewing potential changes to the CDBG-DR Action Plan to determine if funds might be available to offset some of the additional costs. This might impact projects that are included in the current plan.

The Planning Department has approved several applications for funding to repair owner-occupied homes that were damaged in the 2011 flood.

The Watson Blvd. floodwall closure is on hold pending a final commitment of funds from New York State.

The long-awaited demolition of the BAE facility in Westover is nearly complete. The building has been demolished and the foundation and related site improvements are being removed. The Planning Department has begun discussions with the US Army Corps of Engineers regarding survey work that will need to be done in order to move forward with repairs to the Westover flood levee. The Baltimore Office indicated that a review of the levee will be part of an extensive review of the entire Susquehanna River Basin watershed. The watershed project is underway and several public meetings have been conducted.

As of the end of the report period, the Town has expended\$5,389,300.47 of the \$10,137,818 grant (roughly 56%).
