### **Narratives**

#### **Disaster Damage:**

The flooding that occurred September 7-9, 2011 severely affected five neighborhoods in the Town of Union and caused considerable damage in twelve others. The flooding that occurred both in 2005 and 2006 were confined to two major areas in the Town, those being the South Endwell area and the Fairmont Park subdivision. In 2011, in addition to these two areas, the Westover and West Corners areas were severely affected by flooding. Three of the areas, South Endwell, Fairmont Park, and Westover are affected by backwater from the Susquehanna River. West Corners is affected by the Nanticoke Creek. The Nanticoke Creek affects areas in the western part of the Town of Union including the Route 26 corridor, West Corners, Glendale Drive, and West Endicott. These areas are also subject to backwater effect of the Susquehanna River. That is, once the Susquehanna River rises above a certain stage, floodwaters from the Susquehanna River will back up into the Nanticoke Creek affecting properties in the western portion of the Town.

#### **Recovery Needs:**

Based upon the surveys, it appears that there are still substantial unmet needs in the community. Homeowners estimated unmet needs at approximately \$4.5 million (an average of \$37,488 per unit however this number includes properties that will be demolished) while business and non-profits estimated remaining unmet needs at just over \$3 million (an average of \$100,043).

In addition to the unmet housing and business needs previously identified, floodwaters took a significant toll on the basic infrastructure throughout the Town. Roads, storm water facilities, sanitary sewer plants, and water treatment plants also suffered significant damage and substantially complicated the Town's emergency response efforts. Many of these facilities were built decades ago and were not designed to handle subsequent population growth and resulting development. These facilities are overwhelmed by the ever increasing intensity of storm events and can't be maintained into the future without significant repairs and flood mitigation measures. Private utilities also experienced significant flood related damage to service delivery components.

#### **Public Comment:**

The Town received a total of sixteen (16) comments on the Action Plan prior to approval by the Town Board and subsequent submission to HUD. Many of the comments were directed at inadequate infrastructure or infrastructure that was damaged during the flood event. Several comments related to the potential use of CDBG-DR funds to assist property owners who wish to particiapte in the FEMA sponsored buy-out program.

### **Overall Progress Narrative:**

A number of the projects included in the HUD-approved Action Plan for Disaster Recovery are completed or currently underway.

Phase 2 of the Loder Ave. Drainage Project has now been substantially completed. Additional costs were been incurred due to unforeseen subsurface field conditions. The cost of the project increased due to additional material testing, trucking of unsuitable material off-site, tipping fees at the Broome County landfill, and increased quantities of suitable backfill material. Final payment on this project will be made during the first quarter of 2018.

Design of the JC Water Treatment maintenance facility is complete. Estimated constructions costs exceed the amount of funds available and the Village of Johnson City is pursuing other CDBG-DR funds from New York State to fill the funding gap. Due to the long approval process utilized by the state, the bid for actual construction is now expected to be issued in the first quarter of 2018 with construction completed during the 2018 construction.

A contract was executed for design of the JC Interceptor B project and field survey work was completed. During the initial design process, subsurface conditions rendered the proposed method of construction (direct bore) infeasible. The scope of the project was expanded to collect and direct the interceptor B storm water to Grand Ave. via new catch basins and storm pipe. The existing combined sanitary/storm sewer on Grand Ave. is being separated. And a new storm line will be installed on Grand Ave. from Cook St. to Willow St. The new Interceptor B storm lines will tie into the new storm line along Grand Ave. The Project design is ongoing and the project will be let for constructions bids during the first quarter of 2018.

A contract for engineering/design of the West Creek stream bank stabilization project was awarded during the current report period and design is underway. Due to NYSDEC and USACE regulations actual construction can't begin until after July 16, 2018.

The Watson Blvd. floodwall closure project has now been completed.



The procurement process for installation of backflow prevention devices for homes impacted by the 2011 flood has been completed. Work will begin once weather conditions permit.

The demolition of the BAE facility in Westover is now complete. The Planning Department has begun discussions with the US Army Corps of Engineers regarding survey work that will need to be done in order to move forward with repairs to the Westover flood levee. The Baltimore Office indicated that a review of the levee will be part of an extensive review of the entire Susquehanna River Basin watershed. The watershed project is underway and several public meetings have been conducted.

As of the end of the report period, the town has expended \$6,548,626.39 of the \$10,137,818 grant (roughly 68%).
