

Accumulating snow is predicted to fall from Wednesday (12/16) afternoon into Thursday (12/17) morning. Please keep all vehicles off of the road until the storm has ended and the roads have been plowed.

NO PARKING IS PERMITTED ON ANY ROADWAY IN THE TOWN OF UNION AFTER A 2" SNOWFALL.

VIOLATORS ARE SUBJECT TO BEING TICKETED AND/OR TOWED AT THE OWNERS EXPENSE.

The Town provides snow & ice control to promote safe vehicular travel during the winter months. Snow removal efforts include snow plowing and salt applications, and when necessary in congested areas loading snow into trucks to be hauled away. Town crews plow the main roads first, and then the secondary roads.

Chapter 214 of Town Highway Law allows for a \$ 100.00 penalty for depositing snow and ice on any road or highway. In addition, Highway Law, Section 319, Article 11, states that municipalities are not responsible for damage to any mailboxes.
