Economy

Prior to the early 1990's, the economy of the Town of Union had always depended traditionally on large manufacturing operations such IBM and Endicott-Johnson. During the early 1990's the regional economy was devastated by the loss of more than 10,000 manufacturing jobs over a short period of time.

Most of the job creation since the 1990's has been with home grown mfg. companies, and nationally recogized hi-tech companies like BAE Systems, and Rockwell Collins, to name a couple, there has also been continued growth in retail, back office operations, and the health care industry, in addition to an increase in emplyment within higher education and state government sectors.
