The Project includes the following Work:

1. The proposed project will replace the existing underground pump station with a new wetwell and submersible pump station. The project will include new electrical components, pumps and pump controls and discharge pipeline components in a new duplex submersible pump station which is operating beyond its effective useful life. In addition, a new 35KW emergency generator and relocated pump controls and remote monitoring system will be constructed on an adjacent Steel Platform. Bypass pumping during construction is required. The project will require excavation of the new wetwell to a depth of approximately 27' below ground surface and will require shoring and dewatering at a minimum. Other station improvements will include new valving, valve pit, a maintenance crane base and site restoration.
