All written comments, along with the Town's response to each comment, will be included in the submission to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development. The Public Hearing will be held in the Town Board meeting room located on the second floor of the Town Office Complex located at 3111 East Main Street in Endwell. The Town Board is expected to deliberate and approve the adoption of said plan on Wednesday, October 2, 2019 at a regular meeting commencing at 7:00 PM.
