MS. MILLER: We will open the Public Hearing, and I will read the public notice.

The Town of Union Planning Board will conduct a public hearing relative to an application for the NY Union I and Union II LLC – 4311 Watson Boulevard Solar Farm Project Subdivision submitted by NY Union I, LLC and Union II LLC. The subdivision is part of a renewable energy facility project of one 4.98-MegaWatt alternating current (MW a.c.) and an adjacent 4.75-MW a.c. renewable energy solar system at 4311 Watson Boulevard (Tax Map number: #126.04-1-10.111). In order for solar projects to be classified as Community Distributed Generation solar farms, the Public Service Commission (PSC)

limits them to a maximum of 5-MW a.c., and each must be on a unique parcel with its own tax ID number.

The public hearing will take place on Tuesday, September 13, 2022, at 7:00 PM in the Town Board Meeting Room on the second floor of the Town of Union Office Building located at 3111 East Main Street, Endwell, New York. The application is available for review in the Town of Union Planning Department during normal business hours (8 AM to 4 PM).
