2019 REFUSE/RECYCLING INFORMATION

Cardboard Recycling: Residents may use their recycling buckets for cardboard collection as long as the cardboard is not longer than 48 inches in length, fits and is fully contained within the bin. For larger pieces of cardboard or large amounts, the Town provides a separate cardboard collection site at the Construction & Demolition Debris facility on Scarborough Dr.

Yard Waste Collection: Starts the week of April 8, 2019 and ends December 12, 2019. Yard waste will be collected curbside. Grass and leaves must be in garbage cans, **not to exceed 33 gallons in volume, no heavier than 50 pounds. NO BAGS OR CARDBOARD BOXES WILL BE ALLOWED.** Brush and branches must be tied in manageable bundles, no longer than 6 feet, no heavier than 50 pounds. No brush from tree removal or site clearing will be collected.

Christmas Trees: See Web site for Information

Appliances\White goods, (refrigerators, stoves, etc.) Will be picked separately. White goods pick-up must be requested by phoning **786-2980**. White goods are collected according to personnel and equipment availability, please allow 2-3 weeks for pick-up.

Carpeting will be collected with your garbage. It must be bundled, no longer than six (6) feet, no heavier than 50 pounds. Padding must be prepared the same as carpeting.

Tire Disposal: Tire disposal permits may be obtained from the clerks office. The fee is \$ 3.00 per tire, regardless of size & must be off the rim. Disposal is at our C&D facility on Scarborough Drive. Some restrictions apply, call 786-2980 for more information.

Construction & Demolition debris or oversized items (swing sets, metal desks, plumbing fixtures, etc.) must be taken to the C&D facility, located on Scarborough Dr. Construction & Demolition material from contractors or tradesmen will not be accepted. No household garbage accepted.

LIMITS: One (1) visit per month with up to a maximum of 1 cubic yard (average car trunk full)
You must show proof of residency (you must live in the Town of Union, except Johnson City)
