<u>Resolution</u> Board approve and adopt the Town of Union Alternative Energy Tax Exemption PILOT Law that was the subject of a public hearing on December 2, 2020 and to authorize the Town Clerk and Town Attorney to attend to all necessary filings.

<u>Resolution</u> to approve the retention of GAR Associates for professional services in the amount of \$3000.00 to assist the Assessor and Town Attorney.

Resolution to approve the Supplemental Agreement #2 with New York State Department of Transportation for the Intersection Improvements of Hooper Road (CR 33) at Watson Boulevard Project. This is a Locally Administered Project. The estimated cost for the Construction and Construction Support and Construction Inspection work is \$472,768. The Town will be reimbursed 80% of \$472,768, or \$378,214, with Federal funds. In addition, the Town will be reimbursed \$43,800 with State Marchiselli funds. Authorization includes the Supervisor to execute all such project related documents subject to review and approval of the Town Attorney.

<u>Resolution</u> authorizing the increase in the Town of Chenango sewer fee to \$303.16 per user for the Lewis Road Sewer District as per paragraph 4 of the Sewer Use Agreement and increase the flat sewer billing fee to \$132.83 per quarter for non-metered Town of Union sewer accounts.
