Whereas, Andrew M. Cuomo, Governor of New York State issued Executive Order No. 205 Quarantine Restrictions On Travelers Arriving in New York, requiring the New York State Commissioner of Health, Dr. Howard Zucker, to issue a travel advisory requiring all travelers coming from states with significant rates of transmission of COVID-19 (hereinafter "designated states") to quarantine for a 14-day period from the time of their last contact within such designated state;

Whereas the Town of Union will follow the Interim Guidance for Quarantine Restrictions of Travelers Arriving in New York State Following Out of State Travel, which sets forth the policies to be followed in New York State to effectuate the Department of Health travel advisor:

Now, therefore, it is

Resolved, that Town of Union employees are responsible for reviewing the list of designated states, which is updated at <a href="https://coronavirus.health.ny.gov/covid-19-travel-advisory">https://coronavirus.health.ny.gov/covid-19-travel-advisory</a>, "Restricted States";

Resolved, that any Town of Union employee who visits a designated state must notify their department head upon their return to New York State;

Resolved, that a quarantine period will require employees to use accrued time or leave without pay.
