Resolution authorizing Supervisor Robert Mack to execute an agreement with Metro Interfaith Housing Management Corp., 21 New St., Binghamton NY, 13903 for professional services in connection with the Town of Union Home Improvement/First Time Home Buyer programs funded through the CDBG grants. Services shall include program intakes, client processing, perform income verifications, send approval letters and transmit all information to Town Attorney for closings, provide one on one and group counseling/education, provide Certified Housing Counseling Agency status to the Town of Union programs. Funding for this contract is available in the CDBG Home Improvement/First Time Home Buyer budget lines. Metro Interfaith fee schedule: <u>Home Improvement</u>: Initial intake: \$200/client; executed mortgage: \$600/client. <u>First Time Home Buyer</u>: \$350/client.

<u>Resolution</u> to call for a Public Hearing on Wednesday, 4/19/2023 at 7:00 P.M. to receive Public Comment on the proposed Substantial Amendment to the 2019 CARES ACT: CDBG-CV & CDBG-CV3 Annual Plan for the following project:

<u>CDBG-CV & CV3</u>: The Town will use CDBG-CV & CV3 funds to provide financial assistance to the Johnson City School Districts Wildcat Food & Clothing program. The Town of Union will use \$74,000 of unprogrammed CDBG-CV3, and reallocate: \$1,000 from IDIS #1511. These funds will be moved into new project activity IDIS #1726. Total Project Cost: <u>\$75,000.00</u>



<u>Resolution</u> to increase the Town of Union's current First Time Home Buyer Home Price Limit from \$90,000.00 to \$150,000.00 to adjust for the current economic climate and to bring the competitiveness of the Town of Union program in-line with other local agencies and municipalities.
