<u>Resolution</u> to award the Bid for Taft Heights and Hooper Road Pump Stations - Contract #1 General to the low bidder G. DeVincentis & Son Construction Co., Inc. for their bid of \$2,542,000. This project will be paid for from ARPA funds.

<u>Resolution</u> to reject the Bids for Taft Avenue and Hooper Road Pump Stations – Contract #2 Electrical from low-bidder number one Shuler-Haas Electric Corp. for their bid of \$368,130 and reject low-bidder number two Panko Electrical for their bid of \$443,000.

During bid canvasing our project consultant GHD was able to confirm that low-bidders 1 and 2 did not include Variable Frequency Drives (VFDs) in their bid price and would not recommend accepting a bid without the VFDs being included as called for in the bid documents.

<u>Resolution</u> to award the Bid for Taft Avenue and Hooper Road Pump Stations – Contract #2-Electrical to Diekow Electric, Inc. for their bid of \$504,000 (Low-Bidder number three). This project will be paid for from ARPA funds.
